“OWLS” PROVIDES TUITION WAIVER AT THE DOTHAN CAMPUS AND FT. RUCKER LOCATION FOR ADULTS RETURNING TO SCHOOL

The Older, Wiser Learners' Scholarship (OWLS) allows qualified* adults who have not attended a high school, a college, or a university for at least three calendar years to enroll for one 3-hour undergraduate or graduate course. In cases involving the General Education Diploma (GED), the three calendar years will be calculated from the date of completion. The scholarship will pay tuition for one 3-hour undergraduate course (\$705 in-state tuition/\$1,410 out-of-state tuition), or one 3-hour graduate course (\$870 in-state tuition/\$1,740 out-of-state tuition) offered only at the Dothan Campus and Ft. Rucker Location **for Dothan students**. The OWLS Scholarship does not cover the cost of books, supplies, any fees, or any other expenses. The recipient must use the OWLS Scholarship the first semester upon his or her return to school. OWLS will be available to individuals only once.

Students may register for a Dothan Campus or a Ft. Rucker Location course of their own choosing from the Dothan/Ft. Rucker academic schedule of undergraduate and graduate offerings only. *Students must meet any prerequisites. **No on-line (eTroy) courses will be paid for by the OWLS Scholarship.** If you are awarded an OWLS Scholarship, you will be notified by letter. The OWLS application must be approved prior to the student's registration. **No reimbursement of tuition will be made.**

The **deadline** to apply for the OWLS Scholarship **for Summer Semester 2012 is Monday, May 7, 2012.** Admission to the OWLS program is not automatic; students must apply and **must** meet the published deadline. In order for the OWLS application to be approved, an OWLS applicant must apply, must receive admission, and **must enroll and register for classes offered only at the Dothan Campus and Ft. Rucker Location.** Students admitted with the status of transient, post-baccalaureate, post-master's, second baccalaureate, second master's, and graduate special or temporary admission students are **not** eligible for OWLS.

Funding for the OWLS program is limited. Therefore, all qualified applicants may not be approved. Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
