## CALL FOR PAPERS

The 37<sup>th</sup> annual meeting of the Alabama Association of Historians will be held February 6 and 7, 2009, at The University of West Alabama in Livingston, Alabama.

The Program Committee welcomes proposals from all members of the Association (academic and nonacademic), from affiliated societies, from historians working outside United States and/or Alabama History, and from scholars in related disciplines. The committee wishes to encourage creativity and innovation, both with regard to intellectual content and presentation. All topics and time periods, as befits AAH's role as a meeting ground for History professors and K-12 teachers are welcome, as are both individual proposals and panel presentations.

All proposals must be submitted by **January 5, 2009**. Proposals for panels must include a list of all presenters (individual proposals may be asked to join a panel presentation befitting the topic). Proposals must include the following:

**A one-page abstract of a 20-minute presentation.**

**A résumé that includes the author's postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, and academic affiliation, if any.**
